

# MILITARY ENVIRONMENTAL EXPOSURES CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS

Risks from military environmental exposures are a concern for many Veterans, and VA is committed to providing exposure-informed care. This curriculum is designed to equip health care professionals with the knowledge and skills needed to effectively identify, treat, and manage the effects of military environmental exposures in Veterans.

Two certifications are available at no cost and can be completed through Talent Management Systems (TMS) for VA health care professionals and Training Finder Real-Time Affiliate-Integrated Network (TRAIN) for non-VA staff.



## **Level 1 Certification**

Gain the foundational skills and knowledge needed to effectively identify, treat, and manage the effects of possible environmental exposures in Veterans.

#### **Program content includes:**

- Assessing Deployment Related Environmental Exposures
- ☐ Airborne Hazards
- □ Gulf War Illness
- Chronic Multisymptom Illness
- ☐ Depleted Uranium and Toxic Embedded Fragments

Those who successfully complete all course components in Level 1 will receive 5.75 CEU credits.

### **Level 2 Certification**

Advance clinical knowledge on commonly reported military environmental exposures through case-based learning. This certification is available to those who successfully complete the Level 1 certification.

- ☐ Vietnam and Agent Orange Health Concerns
- ☐ Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Exposures
- ☐ Gulf War I Service and Non-Gulf War Illness Conditions
- ☐ Ionizing Radiation and Health Concerns for Veterans

Those who successfully complete all course components in Level 2 will receive 10.5 CEU credits.
